MAHARASHTRA DAY

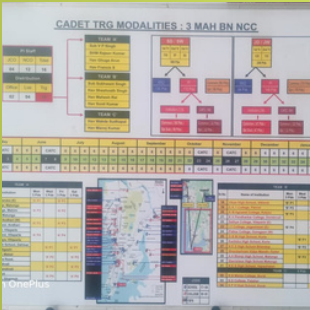
On 1st May Maharashtra Day was celebrated with the hoisting of the flag and singing songs telling the story of the state to commemorate the formation of the state of Maharashtra.
